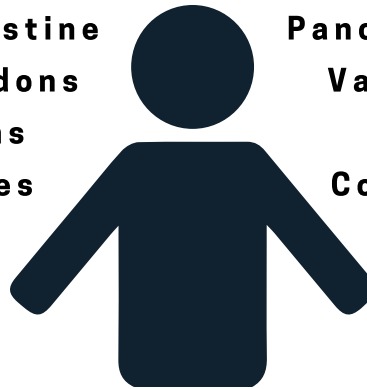

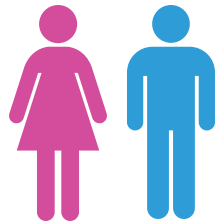




All major religions in the United States support donation and view it as a final act of love and good will.
